Parish News

The Holy Rosary before 10.30am Sunday Mass Our parishioners lead the Rosary before Sunday Mass at 10:00am. People are approached and asked if there are any intentions they wish to be prayed for. These are remembered during the Mass. **Come earlier, for 10:00am, so that you can join your prayers with those in our parish,** for your intentions, for those you love, for our parish, for the Church, for any matter that troubles you, or others or that needs prayer.



First Saturday Devotions Frs Philomeno & Faustino will be here on **Saturday 7th September** to lead us in an Act of Reparation, starting at 9.30am with the Joyful Mysteries of the Rosary and the Traditional Mass at 10.00am, followed by the Sorrowful and Glorious Mysteries, Exposition and Benediction, the Litany of Our Lady and Consecration to Our Lady's Immaculate Heart. Confessions will be heard throughout the morning. If you wish to bring lunch there will be a time of catechesis and discussion with the friars in the afternoon.



Tithing by Contactless Card Payment If you can use the contactless device at the back of the Church please do, or volunteer to sort, count and bank the cash collection, it takes an hour on Sunday evening. Card payments don't require counting or taking to the bank, they go straight to the parish bank account and are processed electronically, they still remain anonymous, even if you decide to register your card for gift aid. The device guides you through the gift aid option and you will get an email acknowledgement. Our parish is one of the few in the country being used experimentally to test Contactless Tithing. **To survive we need your tithes.**
